LOCATION.--Lat 40°02'17", long 78°28'19", Hydrologic Unit 02050303, at Bedford.

Owner: U.S. Geological Survey.

AQUIFER.--Onondaga Formation, Middle Devonian age.

WELL CHARACTERISTICS.--Drilled observation artesian well, diameter 6 in., depth 150 ft, cased to 47 ft, open hole.

INSTRUMENTATION.--Continuous strip-chart recorder; electronic data logger with 60-minute recording interval since June 1999.

DATUM.--Elevation of land surface is 1,160 ft above sea level, from topographic map. Measuring point: Top of casing, 3.1 ft above land-surface datum.

REMARKS.--In addition to the daily maximum water level table shown below, daily minimum and mean water levels, since June 1999, are also available from the District Office.

PERIOD OF RECORD.--July 1965 to current year.

EXTREMES FOR PERIOD OF RECORD.--The extremes shown are extremes of the daily maximum depth below land surface for the period of record indicated above.

Highest water level, 2.42 ft above land-surface datum, May 8, 1998 (may have been higher May 9-17, 1998); lowest, 41.42 ft below land-surface datum, Feb. 12, 13, 1966.
